Using NOCTI to Improve Instruction

DESCRIPTION:

Using NOCTI to Improve Instruction

Three locations: October 2 – Central; October 9 – West, October 25 – East

This 40-hour PIL will be delivered in two in-person sessions: One 7-hour initial session and one final 3-hour Report-out session. It will also include four pre-determined 2-hour online sessions (8 hours total) where all participants attend at the same time. The 22 hours of job embedded assignments include four data-driven decision making strategies: (1) Participant will create an action plan for using student achievement data to support instructional decision making. (2) Participants will plan and deliver a brief teacher presentation covering the research-based strategies to improve student learning, student recall, and applying what students have learned to new situations. (3) Participants will create an analysis of student performance by CTC program based on the NOCTI pre-test results (dashboard). (4) Participants will create, implement, and assess the results of an administrative SLO based on the NOCTI dashboard. These four strategies will serve as the job embedded assignments for the PIL.

Participants must bring to the workshop a laptop, their current year's NOCTI pre-test results, the previous year's NOCTI post-test results; one strategy used in their school by teachers with students to assess and improve individual student NOCTI results; and one strategy used in their school by teachers to assess and improve delivery of instruction to impact NOCTI results. Participants will use the NOCTI dashboard to create an administrative SLO (Student Learning Objective) to support improvement in one or more programs whose student achievement is below the school average.

Administrators will gain skill and evidence for components of the Framework for Leadership in Domains: 1b, 1d, 3b, 3c, 3d, 2b, and 4c.
